A Teaching & Learning Programme for New Polytechnic Lecturers











Rationale for Programme

In 2017, the Joint Polytechnic Committee to Enhance Teaching & Learning (JP-CETL) envisioned a joint certification T&L programme for the professional development of new lecturers joining the polytechnic sector.

This one year long joint polytechnic programme is expected to bring synergies across the polytechnics through the pooling of resources, a common understanding of the polytechnic teaching context, and the mutual recognition of teaching qualifications. It is also expected to produce greater visibility, transparency and credibility to the pedagogical practices and standards in the polytechnics.











CTLPE: Programme Outcomes

At the end of the programme, participants will be able to:

- 1. Articulate the key philosophies underpinning polytechnic education
- 2. Design and develop a learner-centred and industry-relevant curriculum
- 3. Establish **learning environments** and **facilitate learning** to support students in achieving the intended learning outcomes
- 4. Design and develop assessment for formative and summative purposes
- 5. Reflect on professional practice to improve learning and teaching

Underpinning these outcomes are teaching and learning ethos and values as well as each poly's desired polytechnic graduate attributes.
