# School Leadership Move-in Programme

**SLMP** is a Teaching & Learning (T&L) Leadership Programme for new and potential School Leaders in the Polytechnic sector

**SLMP** enables School Leaders to enhance their T&L Leadership Capabilities in **three key aspects**

## 1 Driving Educational Change

To be drivers of change for T&L improvement and innovation

## 2 Driving T&L Quality

To evaluate and enhance School's T&L quality for alignment with Institution's direction, to achieve institutional goals

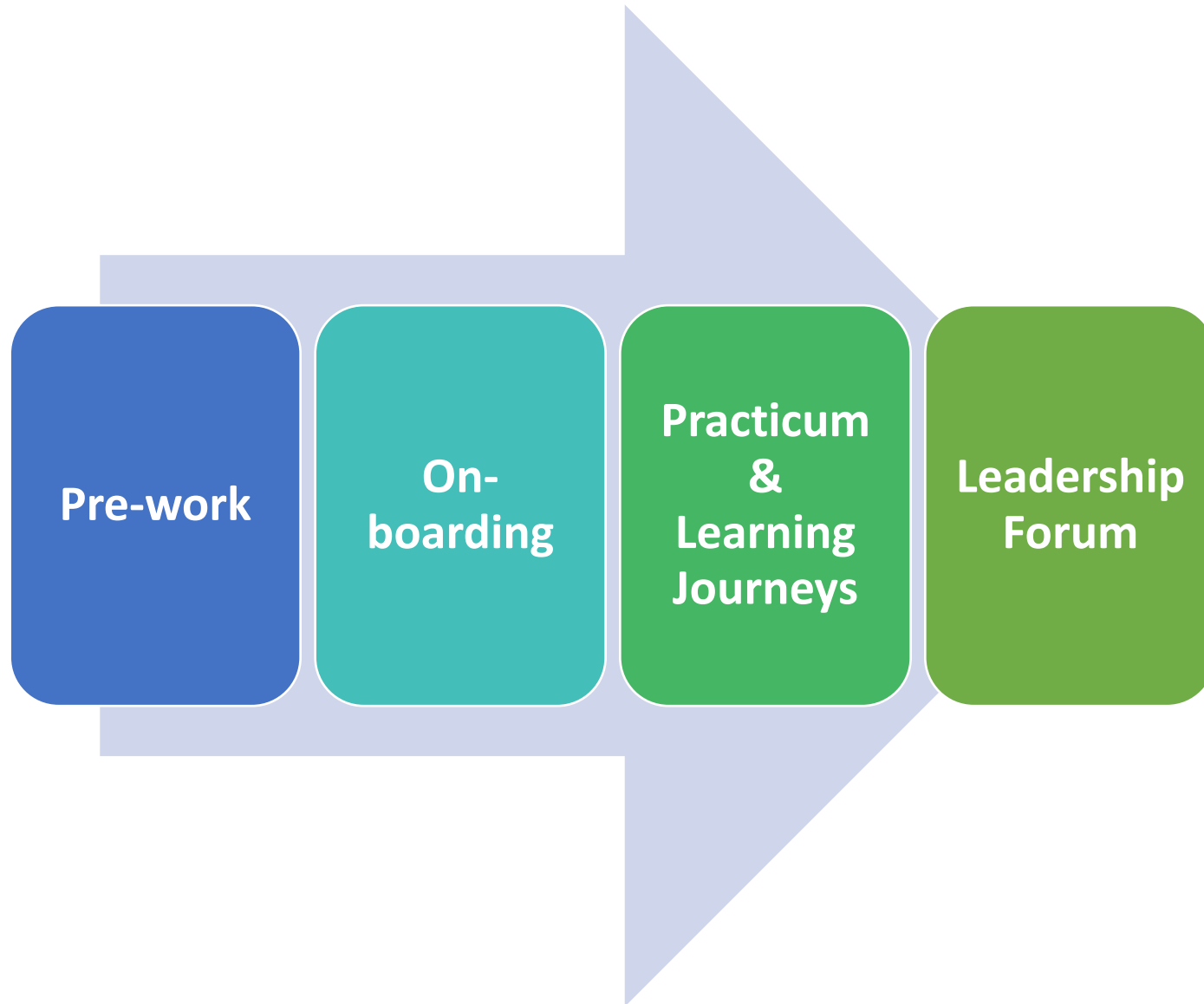
To shape a desired T&L culture within the School

# Pre-work

- This prepares participants for the on-boarding programme.
- Participants generate a list of Teaching & Learning Quality Indicators and Practices used in their School/Polytechnic and the purpose of these Indicators and Practices.
- They also work on the brief description of their proposed SLMP practicum project.

# Practicum

Participants are required to work on a practicum project based on 1 of the 3 themes given in the following:

- Pedagogical Innovation
- Digitization in Education
- Industry Engagement & Training

At the end of Practicum, participants will do a short sharing of their projects.
